APACHE WIND RIDER ZIPTOUR

Take your adventure above and beyond with our Apache Wind Rider ZipTour. This beautifully stunning adventure begins and rises above 11,000 feet. It is complete with parallel cables so riders can glide down the mountain side-by-side. The adrenaline-pumping, three-part ZipTour reaches over 8,900 feet in length, making it one of the longest ZipTours in the world.

GONDOLA RIDES

Take a ride on New Mexico's only eight-passenger gondola and enjoy breathtaking views as you climb to the top of Sierra Blanca. At 12,000 feet, this 360-degree panoramic view is one you don't want to miss.

MOUNTAIN BIKING

Ski Apache offers over 10 miles of trails with challenges for both beginner and experienced riders. Trails start at 11,500 feet and drop in elevation to 9,600 feet. Guided tours and bike rentals are available.
